YALLOURN HIGHER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

-Annual Examination Results.

The results of the Yallourn Higher Elementary School in annual examination, held during 1934 are now to hand and show a gratifying standard of achievement.

In the examination for the Intermediate Certificate, conducted by the University of Melbourne, four out of the seven candidates gained the certificate, the full results being as follows:

- Marjorie Mackenzie Intermediate Certificate, passed in 9 subjects (English, History, French, Arithmetic, Algebra, Geometry, Physical Science, Geography, Drawing).
- Alan Edwards-Intermediate Certificate passed in 8 subjects (English, History, Arithmetic, Algebra, Geometry, Physical Science, Geography, Drawing).
- Doris McGuinness-Intermediate Certificate, passed in 6 subjects (English, French, Arithmetic; Algebra; Physical Science, Drawing).
- Gordon Brown-Intermediate Certificate, passed in 6 subjects (English, History, French, Arithmetic, Physical Science, Drawing);
- Frank Dody-passed in 7 subjects (History, Arithmetic, Algebra, Geometry, Physical Science, Geography and Drawing); but is pending in English.
- Jack Evans secured passes in Physical Science, Geography and Drawing, and

• Jack-Ross in Physical Science.

In the Merit Certificate examination, conducted by the Education Department, 48 candidates were presented, of which the following 24 secured the certificate:
